STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor George H. Freeman of Presque Isle.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey to George H. Freeman of Presque Isle, the south half of section number ninety-five (95) in Mapleton plantation, remitting further settling duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The undersigned, a citizen of Presque Isle, in the county of Aroostook, respectfully represents, that he owns and holds by assignment a certificate of lot numbered south half section 95 in Mapleton plantation, in said county, and that he has paid full value for said certificate. He further represents that the road labor in payment for said lot has been fully completed; that the lot is near the village of Presque Isle, and can be used for the purposes of pasturing cattle, but that it is unfit for the purposes of settlement, or to make a farm.

Wherefore he prays that a Resolve may be passed authorizing the Land Agent to convey said lot to him, waiving all other settling duties required by law.
