STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Otis J. Witham.

Resolved, That the land agent be and hereby is
2 authorized and empowered to deed lot number one
3 hundred and sixteen, in the town of Easton, to Otis J.
4 Witham, without his performing any further settling
5 duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The lot referred to is a swamp lot and not fit for settlement. O. J. Witham lives on one half of his father's lot, which is all hard wood, with no fencing on it. This would work in with his eighty acres of hard wood and make him a good farm. He has performed all the road labor on the lot. All the town officers have signed the petition. It is proper that Mr. Witham should have a deed without performing further settling duties.
