STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

AN ACT fixing the compensation of councillors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Each member of the executive council
2 shall receive the same compensation and travel as a
3 representative to the legislature, for services as a coun-
4 cillor during the annual session of the council com-
5 mencing in January and closing immediately after the
6 adjournment of the legislature. For services at other
7 sessions of the council, each councillor shall be paid
8 two dollars for every day's actual attendance, and two
9 dollars for every ten miles travel one way from his
10 place of abode to the state capital ; and for authorized
11 services on committees when the council is not in ses-

12 sion, three and one half dollars per day and necessary
13 expenses.

SECT. 2. So much of section six of chapter one hun
2 dred and fifteen of the revised statutes, as relates to
3 the compensation of councillors, is hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
