STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

AN ACT giving to municipal and police courts jurisdiction in matters of liens upon personal property in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The ninety-first chapter of the revised
- 2 statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the fol-
- 3 lowing section:
- 4 "Sect. 48. The municipal and police courts of the
- 5 several cities and towns in this state shall have juris-
- 6 diction concurrent with the supreme judicial court and
- 7 trial justices in their respective counties, over liens and
- 8 proceedings relative thereto, for an amount not ex-
- 9 ceeding the sum which limits the jurisdiction of such

- 10 courts in civil actions, to be enforced as provided in11 this chapter."
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved 2 by the governor.
