STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the construction and rebuilding of
bridges on highways.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Every bridge which has been or hereafter
2 may be constructed in this state, as a part of any high-
3 way laid out and established by the county commis-
4 sioners of any county or counties, and costing not less
5 than three hundred dollars, shall be constructed and re-
6 built when necessary by and at the expense of the
7 county or counties in which such bridge may be situ-
8 ated.

SECT. 2. It shall be the duty of the county commis-
2 sioners of the county or counties in which any such
3 bridge may be situate, to make an estimate of the cost

4 of the construction or rebuilding thereof, and provide
5 in their estimates for county taxes the moneys neces-
6 sary to defray the same, and proceed to have such
7 bridge constructed or rebuilt by contract or otherwise
8 as shall seem to them expedient.

SECT. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
