STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Hugh Jamieson.

Resolved, That the land agent be empowered and is
2 hereby required to convey by deed lot of land numbered
3 fifty-five in the town of Presque Isle, in the county of
4 Aroostook, to Hugh Jamieson of said town, and cancel
5 and destroy two notes of hand signed by Jacob Main,
6 and bearing date of December fifteenth, eighteen hun-
7 dred and forty, and now held by the state, the said
8 notes having been given by said Main for said lot of
9 land.

STATEMENT BY COMMITTEE.

We find all the facts set forth in the petition fully confirmed by the Records of the Land Office, and confirmed also by an official letter of Land Agent, which is submitted with this petition; and we further find that the amount paid in road labor at the time by Jacob Main was more than payment for one lot, and that the other the said Main was entitled to without any payment, and that the declared forfeiture was unjust to said Main, and that his title to said land ought to be confirmed to his successors in occupation by deed from the State.
