AN ACT concerning judicial proceedings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Upon the presentation of a petition for review, the

- 2 supreme judicial court or any justice thereof may, in
- 3 term time or in vacation, direct what notice shall be
- 4 given of its pendency, and in all cases where said court
- 5 may order a notice concerning any civil proceeding,
- 6 any justice of said court may in vacation direct what
- 7 notice shall be given by an order endorsed upon the
- 8 process.
