
### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to proceedings in court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. In any personal action now pending or 2 hereafter brought, wherein the plaintiff is liable for 3 damages to the defendant, he may, in writing entered 4 of record with its date, offer to have judgment ren-5 dered against him for a specified sum; and the pro-6 ceedings thereon shall be the same as is provided by 7 section twenty-one of chapter eighty-two of the revised 8 statutes, relating to offers of default; and the effect 9 of such offer upon the rights and liabilities of the 10 plaintiff shall be the same as is therein provided in 11 respect to the defendant.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
