## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to provide for deficiency in the appropriations for the expenditures of government for the year eighteen hundred seventy-four.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECT. 1. In order to provide for a deficiency in sev-

- 4 priated out of any moneys in the treasury, and the
- 5 governor, with the advice and consent of the council,
- 6 is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the

- 9 cents, \$579.09
- 10 Inspectors of steamboats, four hundred ten
