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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend section seventy-four of chapter eleven of the revised statutes, defining the duties of the state superintendent of common schools.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section seventy-four of chapter eleven of the revised  
2 statutes is hereby amended by inserting in line fourth,  
3 between the words "of" and "children," the word  
4 "different;" also by inserting in the fifth line be-  
5 tween the words "age" and "in," the words  
6 "enrolled as scholars," so that said section shall read  
7 as follows :

8 "Sect. 74, The superintendent of common schools  
9 shall, on the first day of June, notify the school com-  
10 mittee of any town whose returns were not received

11 at his office in May, and shall annually ascertain on  
12 the first day of July, the number of different children  
13 between four and twenty-one years of age enrolled as  
14 scholars in the towns from which returns are received,  
15 and furnish a list thereof to the state treasurer.”
