STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

AN ACT in relation to the apportionment of school moneys paid by the state treasurer.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. All apportionments of moneys to be paid
2 from the state treasury in aid of the common schools
3 of this state, shall be made upon the basis of the num-
4 ber of different children between four and twenty-one
5 years of age attending school according to the list of
6 children furnished by the state superintendent of com-
7 mon schools, as provided in section seventy-four,
8 amended by act of legislature, eighteen hundred and
9 seventy-five.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 with this act, are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
