STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE concerning an amendment of the Constitution of
Maine.

Resolved, That the following amendment to the Constitution
2 of this State be proposed for the action of the legal voters of
3 this State, in the manner required by the Constitution, to wit:

4 No. 3.

5 NOVEMBER ELECTION.

6 SECTION 1. The election of such State and County officers
7 as are chosen by popular vote, shall be on the Tuesday next
8 after the first Monday of November, commencing in the year
9 eighteen hundred and seventy-six.

SECTION 2. Section four of Article two, is hereby abrogated.
2 Section four of Article ten, is amended by striking out the
3 word "September," and substituting therefor the word "No-
4 vember." Section seven of Article nine of the amendments,
5 is amended by striking out the words "on the second Mon-
6 day of September," and further amended by substituting the
7 word "November" for the word "September," in the seventh
8 line of said section as printed in the Revised Statutes of eigh-
9 teen hundred and seventy-one. Section nine of the same
10 Article is amended by substituting for the words "the second
11 Monday of September," the words "the Tuesday next after
12 the first Monday of November." The second paragraph of
13 Article ten of the amendments, relative to the vote of citizens
14 in the military service, is amended by substituting for the
15 words "second Monday of September," in the eleventh line

16 as printed in the Revised Statutes of eighteen hundred and
17 seventy-one, the words "on the Tuesday next after the first
18 Monday in November." The same Article is further amended
19 in page fifty-three, in the twentieth line, by striking out the
20 words "second Monday in September," and substituting
21 therefor the words "Tuesday next after the first Monday in
22 November."
