STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

[H. 47.] AN ACT for the protection of owners of stolen bonds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. All actions to recover bonds, obligations
2 or coupons of the same, issued by any city or town
3 in this state, and heretofore stolen or obtained by rob-
4 bery from the owner thereof, and which are now over-
5 due or payable, shall be commenced within one year
6 from the first day of March, A. D. eighteen hundred
7 and seventy-five, and not afterwards; and if not now
8 overdue or payable, within eighteen months from the
9 time they became due or payable, and not afterwards;
10 but this act shall not apply to any action commenced

11 by the person from whom such bonds, obligations or
12 coupons were stolen or obtained by robbery.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
