STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and sixty-two of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, relating to embezzlement of property of deceased persons.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter two hundred and sixty-two of the public

- 2 laws of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-four, is
- 3 amended by repealing the proviso contained in the
- 4 eighth, ninth and tenth lines of said act, so that the
- 5 same as amended shall read as follows:
- 6 "When complaint is made for an examination in re-
- 7 lation to the estates of persons deceased, against per-
- 8 sons fraudulently withholding property belonging to
- 9 such estates, under section sixty-five of chapter sixty-
- 10 four of the revised statutes, as amended by the act in
- 11 relation thereto, approved February eighteenth, eigh-
- 12 teen hundred and seventy-four, the complainant shall

- 13 have the same right whether such person died before or
- 14 after the approval of that act; and all acts and parts
- 15 of acts inconsistent with this are hereby repealed."
