STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-FIVE.

[S. 59.] AN ACT to fix the punishment for murder and
arson.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Murder and arson hereafter committed, shall in all
2 cases be punishable by imprisonment for life, with
3 such solitary confinement as the judge passing sentence
4 may direct.
