STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

[S. 61.] AN ACT for the protection of moose.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall before the first day of 2 October, A. D. eighteen hundred and eighty, take, 3 kill or destroy any moose in this State. Any person 4 violating the provisions of this section shall forfeit the 5 sum of one hundred dollars for every moose so taken, 6 killed or destroyed. Every person who in any way 7 aids or assists in the commission of the aforesaid crime 8 shall be liable to the same penalty as the principal.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall, before the first day 2 October, A. D. eighteen hundred and eighty, have in 3 his possession, keep or sell any moose meat or moose 4 hide, shall be liable to the penalty provided in section

5 first, unless said meat or hide shall have been in his 6 possession at the time this act takes effect.

SECT. 3. The penalties under this act may be 2 recovered by indictment or action of debt in any 3 county where said offence may have been committed, 4 or where such moose, moose meat or moose hide may 5 be found, one half for the benefit of the prosecutor, 6 and the other half to the county in which said indict-7 ment or action may be commenced.
