Amendment "A" to Senate Doc. No. 8.

STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

[S. 46.] AN ACT to repeal chapter three hundred and fourteen of the resolves of eighteen hundred seventy-four, and to revive all acts and parts of acts repealed by said chapter three hundred and fourteen of the resolves of eighteen hundred seventy-four, and to amend section four of chapter five of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The time provided by chapter three hundred and fourteen of the resolves of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, for closing up the affairs of the land office, is hereby extended to December thirty-first, eighteen hundred and seventy-five, and the office of land agent is hereby revived and continued until

7 that date ; and in the meantime the land office shall
8 be maintained and all the books and papers pertaining
9 to the land department be kept at the state house in
10 Augusta.
