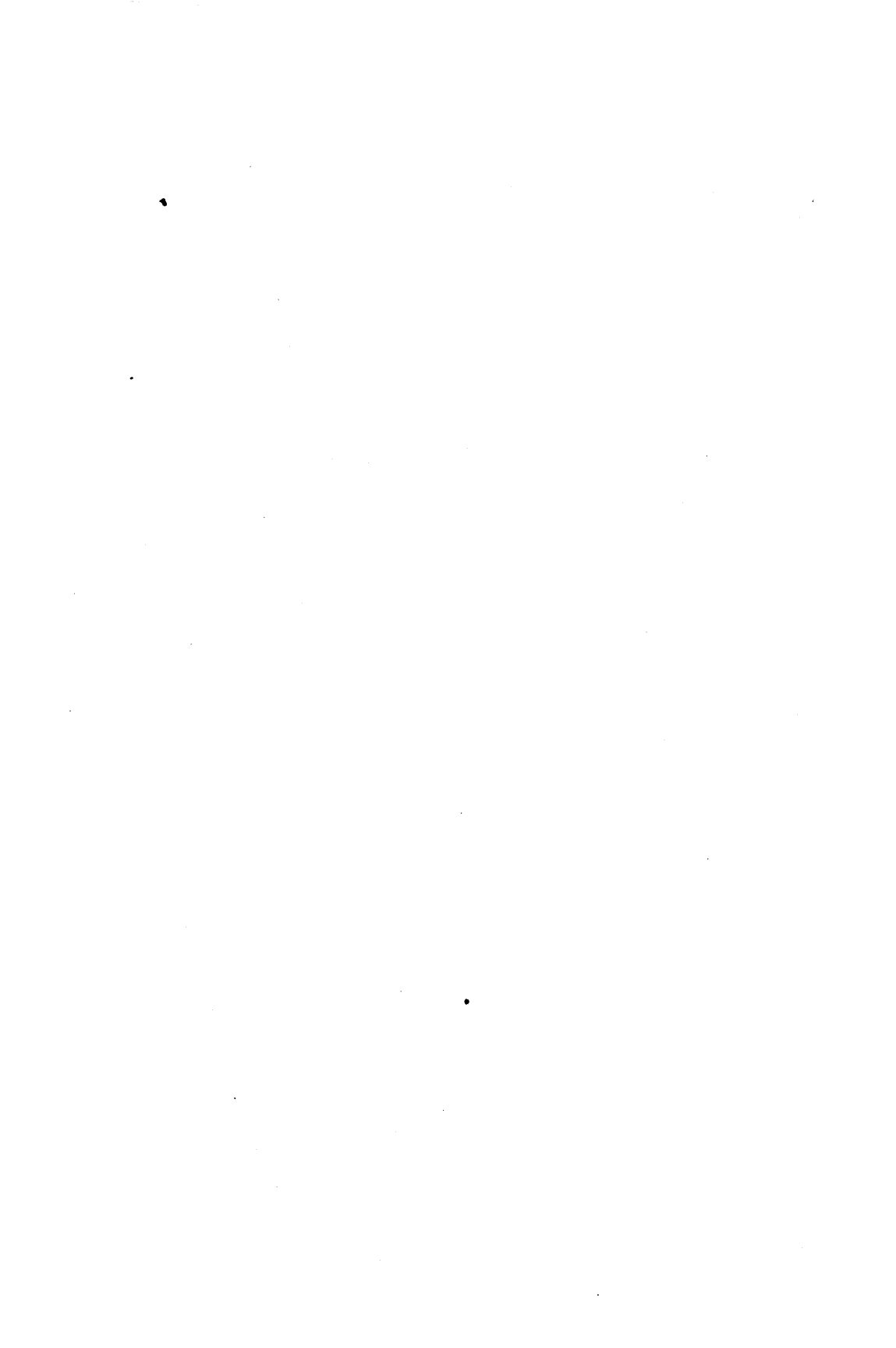

STATE OF MAINE.

[No. 42.] RESOLVE in favor of the Maine state college
of agriculture and mechanic arts.

Resolved, That the sum of twenty-four thousand five
2 hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appro-
3 priated for the purpose of paying existing debts of the
4 Maine state college of agriculture and mechanic arts,
5 erecting new buildings, purchasing apparatus, farm
6 expenses, experiments and improvements, instruction,
7 repairs of buildings, furniture for students' rooms,
8 grading grounds, and making improvements for said
9 college. *Provided however*, that the trustees of said
10 college shall pay from this appropriation the debts now
11 against said college, and shall not under any circum-
12 stances contract any further debts in behalf of said
13 college.
