[No. 51.] RESOLVE in favor of Richard D. Porter.

Resolved, That the land agent be directed to convey
2 to Richard D. Porter, lot numbered sixty-six, (66) in
3 Mapleton plantation, waiving further settling duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The petitioner's lot is located some half mile from any highway, and has bought residence in front of his lot on highway. He has performed all settling duties except establishing residence thereon and asks for deed waiving that much of the settling duties.
