Amendment "B" to Senate Doc. No. 8.

Amend by adding the following sections:

STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

[S. 46.] AN ACT to repeal chapter three hundred and fourteen of the resolves of eighteen hundred seventy-four, and to revive all acts and parts of acts repealed by said chapter three hundred and fourteen of the resolves of eighteen hundred seventy-four, and to amend section four of chapter five of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECT. 3. The land agent, under the direction and
- 2 control of the governor and council, shall as speedily
- 3 as the public good allows, bring to a termination all
- 4 unsettled business connected with the land office and
- 5 relating to the lands belonging to the State.

- SECT. 4. The governor, state treasurer and land 2 agent, are hereby created a commission to inquire 3 what further steps are necessary in order to finally 4 close up the affairs of the land office, and placing the 5 settling land in such custody as shall be for the best 6 interest of the state and hasten their settlement, and 7 report to the next legislature.
- SECT. 5. All the official acts of Parker P. Burleigh, 2 as land agent since the thirty-first day of December, 3 eighteen hundred and seventy-four, are hereby made 4 valid.
