Amendment "B" to Senate Doc. No. 8.

Amend by adding the following sections :

STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

[S. 46.] AN ACT to repeal chapter three hundred and fourteen of the resolves of eighteen hundred seventy-four, and to revive all acts and parts of acts repealed by said chapter three hundred and fourteen of the resolves of eighteen hundred seventy-four, and to amend section four of chapter five of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 3. The land agent, under the direction and
2 control of the governor and council, shall as speedily
3 as the public good allows, bring to a termination all
4 unsettled business connected with the land office and
5 relating to the lands belonging to the State.

SECT. 4. The governor, state treasurer and land agent, are hereby created a commission to inquire what further steps are necessary in order to finally close up the affairs of the land office, and placing the settling land in such custody as shall be for the best interest of the state and hasten their settlement, and report to the next legislature.

SECT. 5. All the official acts of Parker P. Burleigh, as land agent since the thirty-first day of December, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, are hereby made valid.
