STATE OF MAINE.

[No. 48.] RESOLVE, in favor of the Maine insane hospital.

Resolved, That the trustees of the Maine insane hospital are hereby authorized to take in charge the erection and construction of a building which shall contain a hall for a chapel and amusements, and apartments for other purposes, including a kitchen; also provide suitable furniture for the present brick chapel building, so that it can be used for the accommodation of patients, and for the necessary heating apparatus; and the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars is hereby appropriated for the purpose, the bills for the expenditure of which shall be audited by the governor and council.
