STATE OF MAINE.

[No. 56.] RESOLVE relating to a new insane hospital.

Resolved, That the governor, with the advice of
2 council, be and hereby is authorized and directed to
3 appoint a committee consisting of three persons, whose
4 duty it shall be to select a suitable location for a new
5 insane hospital, and take in charge the erection and
6 construction of one pavilion or wing of such a public
7 building ; and for the purpose of carrying on this work
8 for the present year, the sum of fifty thousand dollars
9 is hereby appropriated, the bills for the expenditure of
10 which shall be audited by the governor and council.
