
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

[S. 95.] AN ACT to amend the twenty-second section of the fifty-ninth chapter of the revised statutes, in relation to record of marriages, births and deaths.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The twenty-second section of the fifty-ninth chapter

- 2 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by substi-
- 3 tuting the word "three" for the word "two," in the
- 4 second line, so that said section as amended shall read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 Sect. 22. Whoever neglects to perform the duties
- 7 required of him in the three preceding sections, for-
- 8 feits not exceeding ten dollars for each offence, to be
- 9 recovered by complaint half to the town and half to
- 10 the prosecutor.
