Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized

- 3 tation, in Aroostook county, lot numbered ninety-four,
- 4 in township fourteen, range four, west from east line
- 5 of state, waiving further settling duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Hon. Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled:

The undersigned respectfully represents that he gave notes for lot 99, in Township 14, R. 4, W. E. L. S., some ten years since, and has performed all the settling duties as required by law, with the exception of establishing a residence thereon; that for convenience sake he has erected a dwelling-house on an adjoining lot and now resides on the same, and he requests your honorable body to authorize the Land Agent to issue him a deed of said lot.
