[No. 20.] RESOLVE in favor of Joseph L. Young.

Resolved, That the land agent be and he is hereby
2 authorized and directed to convey by deed to Joseph
3 L. Young of Sherman, lot numbered sixty-seven, in
4 the town of Sherman, county of Aroostook, waiving
5 further settling duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mr. Young has paid for the lot of land named in the resolve and performed all settling duties ; the lot is off from the road, and he has purchased a strip of land lying between the lot and road upon which his buildings are built, thereby obviating the necessity of building a road to said lot, and saving some hundred and fifty dollars to the town.
