IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND HUNDRED AND EIGHT
SEVENTY-FIVE.

[S. 105.] AN ACT to amend chapter seventy-one,
section one, paragraph three of the revised statutes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

That chapter seventy-one, section one, paragraph
2 three of the revised statutes, be and the same is hereby
3 amended as follows: by striking out the word "partial"
4 in the third line, and the word "entire" in the third
5 and fourth lines of said paragraph, so that said para-
6 graph shall read:

7 Of executors, administrators or guardians when it
8 appears by the petition and proof exhibited that the
9 residue would be greatly depreciated by a sale of any
10 portion under the foregoing authority to sell the whole
11 or such parts thereof as will not injure the residue.
