STATE OF MAINE.

[No. 125.] RESOLVE in favor of settlers on proprietors' lands.

Resolved, That the governor, land agent and treasurer
2 of state, are hereby constituted a commission to treat
3 with proprietors of lands on which the settlers specified
4 in Noah Barker's report are located, for the purchase
5 or exchange of said lands; and such commission is
6 hereby empowered to exchange for said lands other
7 lands belonging to the state, or to purchase such lands
8 of the proprietors from the proceeds of state lands to
9 be sold the ensuing season, at a rate not exceeding
10 fifty cents per acre; and in case of such purchase or
11 exchange, the land agent is directed to convey such
12 lands to such settlers according to said report.
