STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend section eighteenth of chapter eighty-eight of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section eighteen of chapter eighty-eight
2 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended, so that it
3 shall read as follows: "an account of all the charges
4 and expenses attending the partition, shall, on request
5 of any petitioner, be presented to the court, and the
6 presiding judge shall determine, after giving notice to
7 all concerned, the equitable proportion thereof to be
8 paid by the several owners in the lands of which par-
9 tion has been made, and execution therefor may be
10 issued against any owner neglecting to pay."

SECT. 2. This act shall not apply to the taxation of
2 costs and payment of expenses in any petition for par-
3 titution now pending.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
