RESOLVE authorizing the land agent to convey to Enoch
Hall a lot of land in Lyndon.

Resolved, That the land agent be and he is hereby
2 authorized to convey by deed to Enoch Hall, lot num-
3 bered forty-eight in the town of Lyndon, waving
4 further settling duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

*To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives of Maine,
in Legislature assembled :*

The undersigned citizens of the town of Lyndon, in the County of Aroostook, would respectfully represent that their townsman, Enoch Hall, is the holder and owner of the Land Certificate of lot numbered forty-eight (48) in said Lyndon ; that he has performed the road labor agreeable to the Act regulating the sale and settlement of the public lands ; that said lot adjoins said Hall's home farm, and is necessary thereto upon account of water and fencing, of which his said farm is deficient ; they therefore ask that a deed of said lot may be given said Hall, waiving all further settling duties, and as in duty bound will ever pray.
