RESOLVE in favor of bridge across the Aroostook river in the town of Maysville, Aroostook county.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be and

- 2 is hereby appropriated for the repair of the bridge
- 3 across the Aroostook river, in the town of Maysville,
- 4 Aroostook county, to be expended under the direction
- 5 of the county commissioners of Aroostook county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge is 480 feet long, and spans the Aroostook river in the town of Maysville, on the direct mail route from Houlton to Fort Kent. It has been maintained wholly by said town of Maysville during the past 15 years, at great expense. The amount of repairs needed this year to make said bridge safe, is estimated at one thousand dollars. The course of the Aroostook river through said town is so circuitous as to make the maintenance of bridges and highways unusually burdensome and oppressive, the town valuation being but \$146,000, and there being eight other large bridges and a number of smaller ones now maintained by said town.
