STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend chapter twenty-four, sections twentytwo and twenty-three of the revised statutes, relating to relief of needy persons.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Erase all of eleventh and twelfth lines,
- 2 commencing with the word "town," in eleventh line,
- 3 to the period in twelfth line, and insert instead thereof,
- 4 "Counties wherein such unincorporated place is located
- 5 as one town has against another town for relief of
- 6 needy persons;" so that the clause shall read as follows:
- 7 "When relief is so provided, the towns furnishing it
- 8 are entitled to the same remedies against the county
- 9 wherein such unincorporated place is located as one
- 10 town has against another for relief furnished needy
- 11 persons."

In section twenty-three, erase in fifth line, "town 12 13 where such person had a settlement," and insert in lieu 14 thereof, "county wherein such unincorporated place 15 was located." Also, in section twenty-three, tenth 16 line, erase the word "town," and insert "county," so 17 that said twenty-third section shall read as follows: "A person residing in a place not incorporated may 19 provide relief and medical aid for any person sick, 20 wounded or dangerously injured, residing in such place, 21 and in case of death may cause them to be buried, and 22 recover the amount necessarily expended of the county 23 wherein such unincorporated place is located, if within 24 sixty days after he has delivered into a post office, 25 postage paid, a written notice signed by him, inform-26 ing them of the name of the person relieved, the nature 27 of his sickness or injury, if known, and the amount Counties paying such expenses or costs 28 expended. 29 may recover the amount with interest of the persons 30 relieved or of any one liable for their support."
