STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Passamaquoddy Indians.

Resolved, That the agent of the Passamaquoddy
2 Tribe of Indians is hereby directed to take or cause to
3 be taken, a census of said tribe each year, before the
4 time of the payment of the May dividends to said
5 tribe, and that said agent report the same in his annual
6 report of said tribe.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Honorable, the Legislature of the State of Maine for 1876:

I, the undersigned, member of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians, respectfully represent that it would be a great benefit to the tribe to have a census taken every year by our agent or some other person, and respectfully pray that you will pass a law to that effect.
