STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend section three of chapter seventy of the revised statutes, in relation to the time in which assignees shall file an inventory in probate court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section three of chapter seventy of the
- 2 revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the
- 3 word "ten" in the fourth line of said section, and
- 4 inserting in the place thereof the word "twenty," so
- 5 that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:
- 6 Sect. 3. The assignee named in such assignment
- 7 shall give a bond to the judge of probate in such sum
- 8 and with such sureties living in the county as shall be
- 9 satisfactory to him, and shall immediately thereafter
- 10 take possession of the property assigned, and within

- 11 twenty days after the execution of the assignment shall
- 12 file in the probate office an attested copy thereof and
- 13 an inventory under oath of all the real estate, goods,
- 14 chattels, rights and credits of the assignor which have
- 15 come to his possession or knowledge, whether contained
- 16 in the assignment or not; said bond shall be condi-
- 17 tioned as follows:
- 18 First. To return into the probate office within ten
- 19 days after the time allowed to creditors to become par-
- 20 ties to the assignment, an inventory of any real or
- 21 personal estate of the assignor, not already returned,
- 22 whether contained in the assignment or not, and the
- 23 names of all creditors who have become parties to the
- 24 assignment with a list of their respective claims.
- 25 Second. To make proportional distribution of all the
- 26 net proceeds of such estate among such creditors as
- 27 become parties to the assignment.
- 28 Third. To render a true account of his doings on
- 29 oath to the judge of probate within six month, and at
- 30 any other time when cited by the judge.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved 2 by the governor.
