STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to extend the powers of school districts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any school district, by a majority vote of those

- 2 present, at any legal meeting duly warned, may trans-
- 3 fer the scholars of any grade in such district to any
- 4 academy or private or corporate school, and may
- 5 appropriate and pay the tuition of the scholars so
- 6 transferred from the funds of said district, to such an
- 7 amount as, in the judgment of the majority of the dis-
- 8 trict, will not impair the efficiency of said district
- 9 school; provided, that the superintending school com-
- 10 mittee of the town in which such district is situated
- 11 shall have the same control over the studies and text-
- 12 books of said scholars as in the district school.
