STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to extend the powers of school districts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Any school district, by a majority vote of those
2 present, at any legal meeting duly warned, may trans-
3 fer the scholars of any grade in such district to any
4 academy or private or corporate school, and may
5 appropriate and pay the tuition of the scholars so
6 transferred from the funds of said district, to such an
7 amount as, in the judgment of the majority of the dis-
8 trict, will not impair the efficiency of said district
9 school ; *provided*, that the superintending school com-
10 mittee of the town in which such district is situated
11 shall have the same control over the studies and text-
12 books of said scholars as in the district school.
