STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend section five of chapter one hundred thirty-eight of the revised statutes, relating to fugitives from justice.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section five of chapter one hundred and 2 thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended 3 so as to read as follows:

4 Whenever any prisoner who has been convicted of, or 5 charged with, a capital crime or other high offence 6 escapes from prison in this State, or there is reason-7 able cause to believe that any person who is charged 8 with such offence and has not been apprehended there-9 for, cannot be arrested and secured in the ordinary

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10 course of proceedings, the governor may, upon appli-11 cation in writing of the attorney general or county 12 attorney for the county in which such offence was 13 committed, and upon such terms and conditions as he 14 may deem expedient and proper, offer a suitable 15 reward not exceeding one thousand dollars, for the 16 arrest, return and delivery into custody of every such 17 escaped prisoner or fugitive from justice, and upon 18 satisfactory proof that the terms and conditions of such 19 offer have been complied with, may, with the advice 20 of the executive council, draw his warrant upon the 21 treasurer for the payment thereof.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
