AN ACT in relation to the settlement of paupers.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

No person shall acquire a settlement subjecting a  
2 town to pay for his support on account of poverty or  
3 distress, by reason of his residing in said town as  
4 tender of a draw bridge, or toll keeper of a bridge  
5 owned by another town, and in a toll house also owned  
6 by another town.
