STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Hiram B. Hersey of Crystal plantation.

Resolved, The land agent be and is hereby authorized
2 to deed to Hiram B. Hersey of Crystal plantation, the
3 south half of section fifty in Crystal plantation.
4 This act shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mr. Hiram B. Hersey has purchased this half section of land under a resolve passed some years ago, and has performed all duties thereby imposed; except paying for a portion of worthless bog land, in road labor. Mr. Hersey has paid all that the Local Agent and Land Agent thinks he should pay. Mr. Hersey being a one-armed man, and obliged to transact his labors alone.
