RESOLVE in favor of Caleb Sherman.

Resolved, That the land agent be and is hereby authorized to convey by deed lot numbered thirty-one (31) in township number five, range three, now Oakfield plantation, to Caleb Sherman, waiving further settling duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS IN CASE OF CALEB
SHERMAN.

Mr. Sherman is a resident of Oakfield plantation, and has been for some time; has paid for lot No. 31 in road labor; has built a barn on said lot and occupied it as his only farm for a number of years; and by reason of not being able to build a house thereon, lives in a house on an adjoining farm owned by Mr. Weeks of Houlton. He intends to make this lot his homestead and Oakfield his residence.
