STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend section seventeen of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the revised statutes, relating to the regulation of fees and costs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The fifth specification of section seven-
2 teen of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the revised
3 statutes, is hereby amended, by adding thereto the
4 following words, "for each defendant named in such
5 return," so that said specification as amended shall
6 read as follows :

7 "For receiving of an officer a copy of return of at-
8 tachment of real estate, minuting it when it is received,
9 keeping it on file, and entering it in a book kept for

10 the purpose, ten cents for each defendant named in
11 such return.”

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
