RESOLVE in favor of Chapman plantation.

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of three hundred dollars be,  
2 and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of  
3 building road in Chapman plantation, Aroostook county,  
4 the same to be expended under the supervision of the  
5 county commissioners of Aroostook county.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

---

The valuation of Chapman Plantation is but \$6,000, and they have  $2\frac{1}{4}$  miles of road to build across a bad bog, which is settled on both sides. It is impossible for the inhabitants to make the road without help from the State. The State has received the past season \$5,400 from the sale of lands in that township, and there remains some 1,453 acres of State lands in the township.
