SEVENTY-SIX.

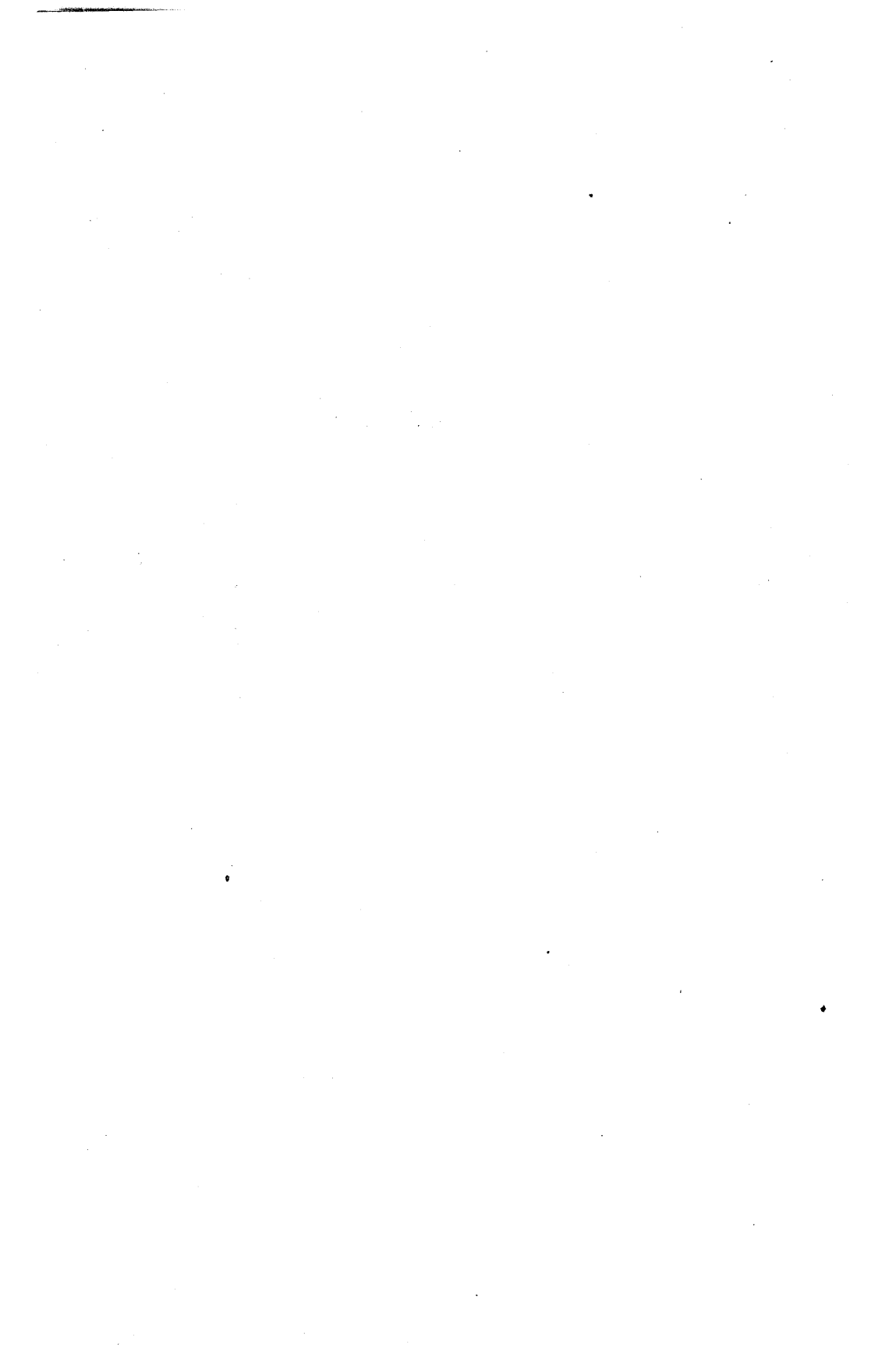
AN ACT relating to the framing of issues in equity cases.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. After the pleadings are filed, and before
2 the testimony is taken in any suit in equity, the court
3 setting in the county where the same is pending may
4 at the request of either party frame issues of fact to
5 be tried by a jury.

SECT 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 the provisions of this act are repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved,
2 but shall not apply to any bill in equity now pending.
