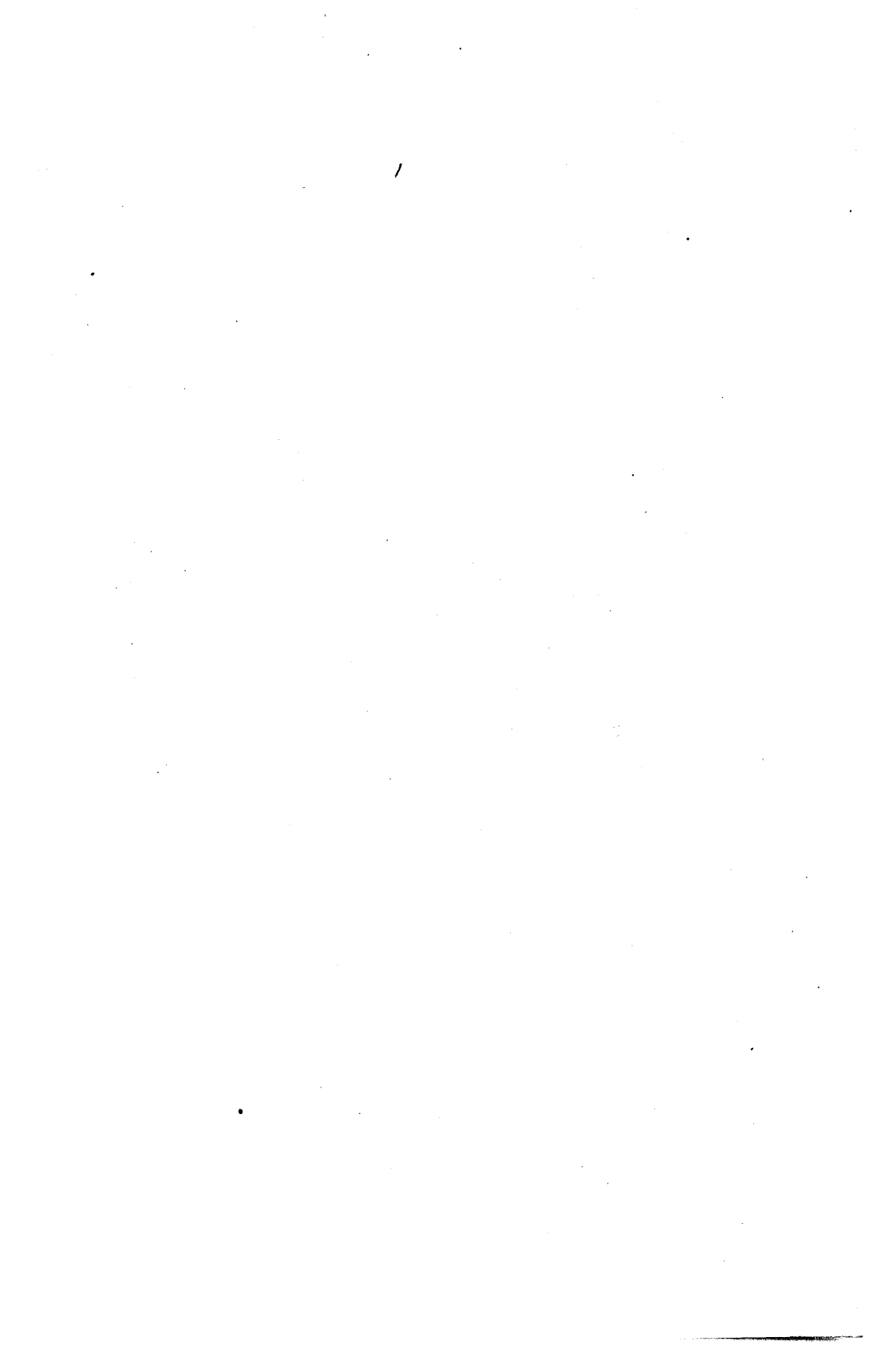

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty-five of the revised
statutes, relating to the distribution of the estates of
persons deceased out of the state.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Chapter sixty-five of the revised statutes is hereby
2 amended, by adding thereto the following section :
3 *Sect. 39.* Where lands in this state held in trust
4 under a foreign will, for persons non-resident here,
5 have been sold, the probate court for the county in
6 which the will has been allowed may, in its discretion,
7 order the money to be transmitted to the trustee, if
8 there is any, in the state or country where the testator
9 had his domicil.
