STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to the claims of settlers on proprietors' lands.

Resolved, That the governor and council be directed 2 to appoint a commissioner, who shall, as soon as prac-3 ticable, treat with the owners of lands described in 4 the report of Noah Barker—made in pursuance of 5 resolve of February twenty-seven, eighteen hundred 6 and seventy-three—for the purchase of said lands or 7 for the exchange for them of other lands owned by the 8 state. And such commissioner is hereby empowered 9 to purchase the land described in said report, at a 10 price not exceeding fifty cents per acre, or to convey 11 to the owners thereof lands belonging to the state of 12 equal value in exchange for them. And such com-13 missioner is hereby empowered and directed to convey 14 to the settlers named in said report, as soon as such 15 purchase or exchange is effected, the lots of land de-

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16 scribed in said report, as occupied by such settlers. 17 And the governor is hereby authorized to draw his 18 warrant upon the treasury for the amount that may be 19 necessary under this resolve for the purchase of said 20 lands, and for the reasonable compensation and expen-21 ditures of said commissioner.
