STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT relating to the appointment of land agent and
his duties.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

It shall be the duty of the governor, with the advice
2 of council, to appoint the land agent, who shall hold
3 his office during their pleasure ; and it shall be his
4 duty under their direction, as speedily as the public
5 good allows, to bring to a termination all unsettled
6 business connected with the land office, relating to the
7 lands belonging to the state, to the end that the office
8 may be discontinued at the earliest practicable
9 moment.
