RESOLVE in favor of W. N. Woodbury.

Resolved, That when W. N. Woodbury shall have
2 shown to the land agent that he is the actual owner
3 of certificate of lot number three, range one, in the
4 east half township number two, range five, and shall
5 have paid to the land agent the sum of twenty-five
6 dollars, the land agent be and is hereby authorized to
7 convey by deed lot number three, range one, in the
8 east half of township number two, range five, to the
9 said W. N. Woodbury.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The claimant, W. N. Woodbury, lives on a lot adjoining this said lot and there is no road to the said lot. He has performed all settling duties except building on this lot, and this lot being a back lot, he desires that his petition be granted.
