RESOLVE in favor of W. S. Evans.

Resolved, That when Winfield S. Evans shall have
2 shown to the land agent that he, W. S. Evans, is the
3 actual owner of certificate of lot number eight, range
4 four, in the east half of township number two, range
5 five, and shall have paid to the land agent the sum of
6 twenty-five dollars, the land agent be and is hereby
7 authorized to convey by deed lot number eight, range
8 four, in the east half township number two, range five,
9 to the said Winfield S. Evans.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The claimant, Winfield S. Evans, lives on a lot adjoining this said lot and there is no road to the said lot. He has performed all settling duties except building on the lot, and this lot being a back lot, he desires that his petition be granted.
