STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT in relation to appeals from county commisioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The provisions of chapter ninety-one of the laws of

- 2 Maine, approved January twenty-nine, eighteen hun-
- 3 dred and seventy-three, shall not apply to any case
- 4 relating to the location, alteration or discontinuance
- 5 of any highway pending at the date of the passage of
- 6 said act, in which a right of appeal was thereby
- 7 annulled, but parties interested may jointly or severally
- 8 apply in writing to the county commissioners in any
- 9 county where such case was then pending within three
- 10 months from the approval of this act for leave to enter
- 11 an appeal to the next term of the supreme judicial
- 12 court in such county, and thereupon said county

13 commissioners shall cause all further proceedings to be
14 stayed, and such parties may enter and prosecute such
15 appeal in said supreme judicial court, with all the
16 rights otherwise provided by law; provided, however,
17 that this act shall not apply to appeals in any case
18 where such highway has been actually built, altered,
19 discontinued or contracted to be built, altered or dis20 continued.
