STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT additional to chapter two hundred and twenty-three of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-one, regulating railroad corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The provisions of section one of chapter
2 two hundred and twenty-three of the public laws of
3 eighteen hundred and seventy-one, shall not be con-
4 strued to prevent railroad corporations from estab-
5 lishing necessary rules and regulations for the cancel-
6 lation of tickets and exchange of partially used tickets,
7 such rules and regulations to be publicly posted at
8 each ticket office and on all passenger trains, and when
9 practicable, printed upon the tickets. And any ticket
10 or check given in exchange for the unused portion of

11 a partially used ticket shall continue in force for the
12 full term of the original ticket as provided in said
13 section.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
